1. Discussion

3. Treasury Report

Accounts receivable: \$1,182.63

4. ED Report

We have one employee on work comp, she is back on restricted duty and is currently away at Peer Support Training. There will be a follow-up meeting with her when she returns.

This Saturday September 30, 2023, is National Mobilized Day of Recovery and the Wellness Center is hosting a "Meat & Greet" event from 11am to 2pm. This event will bring awareness to recovery United States wide and give us an opportunity to highlight the center in Clinton.

Governor Reynolds is planning to visit us on Thursday Oct 5, at 10:15am so we are preparing for this event.

Finally, the remodel of the bathroom at Rhonda's house has been completed, the pantry closet was removed to enlarge the bathroom space and the downstairs bedroom door was relocated to the living room.
